ABOUT AHAD-AP

Association for Haemophilia and Allied Disorders-Asia Pacific (Previously known as APHWG) was formed in 2014 as an independent group of health professionals involved with the care of people with haemophilia and related hereditary bleeding disorders from the Asia Pacific region, with the aim to improve care for people at risk for haemophilia and other hereditary bleeding disorders in the Asia Pacific region. Countries and regions currently represented include Australia, China, Hong Kong, India, Japan, Malaysia, Singapore, South Korea, Taiwan, Thailand and Vietnam.

Over the last 3-4 years AHAD-AP has evolved gradually and is officially incorporated as a legal entity in Singapore in 2020. AHAD-AP has conducted several training workshops, published the Asia Pacific Principles of Haemophilia Care and created a format for outcomes data collection.

The AHAD-AP is governed by a Steering Committee as well as different standing committees.


